PERMITLESS CARRY

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Yes — age 19+ (includes visitors)

RESIDENT PERMIT

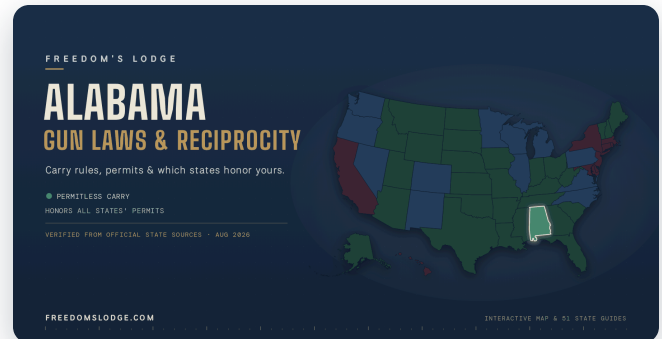
Concealed Handgun Permit (Pistol Permit), issued by county sheriff — issued at 19+

OUT-OF-STATE PERMITS

Honors ALL states' permits

DUTY TO INFORM POLICE

Only if asked — must answer truthfully

KEY RESTRICTIONS & RULES

- Must truthfully answer if an officer asks whether you are armed (quasi duty-to-inform)
- Prohibited: courthouses, police stations, jails, psychiatric facilities, K-12 school premises
- 'No guns' signs carry no force of law; state preempts local ordinances
