GUN LAWS & RECIPROCITY — QUICK REFERENCE

PERMITLESS CARRY

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Yes — age 21+ (includes visitors)

RESIDENT PERMIT

Ohio Concealed Handgun License (CHL) — issued at 21+

OUT-OF-STATE PERMITS

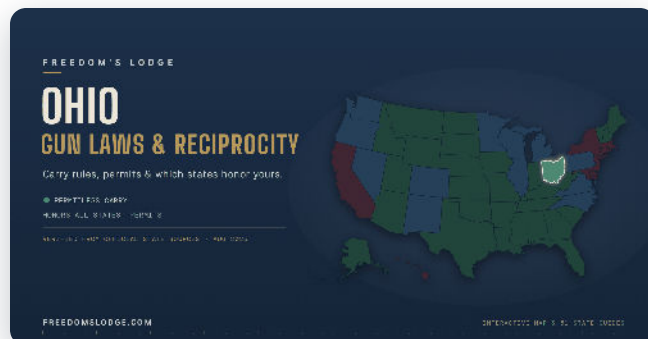
Honors ALL states' permits

DUTY TO INFORM POLICE

Must disclose when asked during a stop

KEY RESTRICTIONS & RULES

- Duty to inform: no proactive duty; must truthfully disclose carrying when an officer asks during a lawful stop (post-SB 215)
- Prohibited: schools, courthouses, certain government buildings; private property may be posted
- Loaded handgun carry in vehicles permitted for qualifying adults without a license
- No magazine capacity limit for handgun carry
